David started the trombone at a relatively “late” age of 14. But within a few years, David has already performed with the region’s professional orchestras and international youth orchestras, obtained the Licentiate Diploma, and became actively involved in chamber ensembles and soloing.

After his studies at the New England Conservatory of Music in Boston, USA under Scott Hartman and the late John Swallow, David was with the Singapore Symphony Orchestra for a decade. He has travelled widely to give trombone workshops at various music festivals and universities around Asia, with concerto performances at China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, the Philippines, Thailand and Malaysia.

David currently teaches trombone at the National University of Singapore, Nanyang Technological University, Singapore Armed Forces Bands, Singapore Management University; and, adjunct faculty at Bansomdejchaopraya Rajabhat University in Bangkok (Thailand), and Xin Hai Conservatory of Music in Guangzhou (China). He is faculty to the SliderAsia Music Festival (Hong Kong), Singapore Low Brass Festival, Thailand Low Brass Festival, and the Philippines Low Brass Festival.

David is the serving President of the Singapore Trombone Society, a Michael Rath artist, and uses exclusively Michael Rath trombones.
