

Ho Law Wei

Law Wei first played the tuba in Fuchun Primary School Brass Band at the age of 9. His passion for music has led him to join the Singapore Armed Forces Band in 2009 as a full time musician.

Under the sponsorship of the SAF Band, Law Wei has studied under Francis Tan and Hidehiro Fujita, Principal Tubist of the Singapore Symphony Orchestra. He is currently studying under Tan Yao Cong, a graduate from the Guildhall School of Music and Drama. Law Wei holds a Fellowship diploma from the Trinity College of Music , London.

Throughout his career as a military musician, Law Wei has attended master classes by established tuba virtuosos like Roger Bobo, Steve Rosse , Sergio Carolino, Tim Buzbee and Øystein Baadsvik.

In 2011, Law Wei was appointed as a Drum Major for the SAF Ceremonial Band and has led the military band in various parades and ceremonies. He has also served as a Drum Major instructor for secondary school NCO Camp in the year 2011 and 2012.

Other than being a drum major instructor, Law Wei has taught in various primary, secondary schools and junior colleges as a tuba tutor and a low brass instructor.

Law Wei has performed with many group and ensembles including the Singapore Wind Symphony(SWS), The Philharmonic Winds, Kim Seng Winds, the Orchestra of the Music Makers (OMM), Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA) orchestra and Brass Band, National University of Singapore (NUS) Harmonica Orchestra, Temasek polytechnic and Alumni band and the New Stream Brass Band which plays Jazz in New Orleans style music.

Law Wei is currently the Principle Tubist of the Singapore Armed Forces Central Band and the Associate Conductor of the Temasek Polytechnic Alumni Band.
