



Singaporean cellist Ryan Sim is a graduate of the Yong Siew Toh Conservatory of Music, having studied under full scholarship with Ng Pei-Sian, Principal Cellist of the Singapore Symphony Orchestra, before going on to further his master's in Germany at the Robert Schumann Hochschule Dusseldorf, graduating with top marks under the guidance of Professor Claus Reichardt.

Ryan has performed in many international music festivals such as the Adelaide International Cello Festival and the Asian Youth Orchestra, and has also played in masterclasses with cellists such as Wang Jian, Gregor Horsch and Wolfgang Boettcher. Ryan is an active chamber musician and plays regularly with local ensembles such as the Re: Sound Collective, TO Ensemble and the Metropolitan Festival Orchestra. He is also the founder and leader of the cello quartet Bossa Celli. Recent engagements include the Singapore production of Les Miserables at the Esplanade Theatre and a solo cello recital 'Celloabend' at The Arts House.
